**91. Cetaphil SPF 50**

This moisturizer has brains (broad spectrum SPF 50) and beauty (its micronized titanium dioxide won't leave a chalky film like so many other physical blockers, says NYC dermatologist Heidi Waldorf). And it's gentle enough for rosacea sufferers. \$16; at CVS.

## CLEANSER

**92. CeraVe Hydrating**

Soap-and-fragrance-free, this milky formula gets it just right. "It contains ceramides that help hydrate and calm the skin," says NYC dermatologist Rosemarie Ingleton. **93. Avène Soothing Moisture**
